

GIRL'S (cont.)

9. Girls 5th grade and up may have small, plain, purses.
10. Girls under 15 years of age are prohibited from wearing any make-up including fingernail polish. Clear top coat is the only acceptable color for girls of any age. Girls above 15 may wear make-up in moderation...however....the school will reserve the right to determine what "moderation" is or is not.
11. Anytime skirts or skorts are worn, knee socks or panty hose must be worn
12. Socks must be white or navy. Panty hose must be navy, white, or beige.
13. Backpacks and Lunch Boxes (if used) must be purchased from "Lands'end" and logoed. Backpacks may also be personalized and coordinated with school colors.

NOTE:

1. On chapel day.....students can bring their regular every day uniform to change into after chapel if they desire.
2. All students (5th grade and under) are required to keep a change of clothes at school that will be placed in their storage bins in case of any accidents that might occur. Parents who do not follow this rule will be charged \$10 for each time they have to be reminded after an incident.
3. 1st grade through High School.....are required to "dress out for PE."
4. Boys and Girls...1st grade and up....are required to wear plain black/brown belts with the pants secured above the hips. The only exception to this is girls who have elastic waist bands with no belt loops.
5. Absolutely no wearing of hats.....at any time....in any building...in any circumstance.
6. If t-shirts are worn underneath uniforms....they must conform to school colors (i.e., red/white or blue). The only exception to this is on P.E. day when it is acceptable to wear the grey P.E. shirts.
7. Students in "after-school care" may bring blue jeans to change into. Jeans must be free of holes.
8. Students are required to remain in uniform while on campus (including detention time).
9. Clothes must fit properly and be well mended and not faded. Warnings will be issued for shirts that are too short, pants that are too long or small, etc.
